Constitution

A review of our constitution has led to a need to consider amendments. Retford GC Ltd is registered as a Limited Company at Companies House and its constitution, in the form of Articles of Association, can be viewed on their website, together with details of the 3 named Directors who bear responsibility for the running of the Company.

However, it is suggested that the other Members of the Management Committee, despite not being named as Directors, might carry the same level of responsibility as the Directors, under the current Articles. For volunteers giving their time freely to support the club, this is unreasonable and unduly onerous.

A new draft set of Articles has therefore been prepared and approved for adoption by the Committee. The draft seeks to

- Limit the responsibility of Directors to those named as Directors
- Simplify the Articles by removing things not relevant to the Companies act. These will be covered in new Bye-Laws.
- Make the Company suited for registration as a Community Amateur Sports Cub if this becomes appropriate in the future.

A General Meeting of members will need to be held for formal adoption of the new Articles, details of which will be issued shortly. Meanwhile a copy of the draft will be available on application to the Communications Group via <u>retfordgolfcomms@gmail.com</u> and another placed on the notice board in the lobby. Any comments or queries should also be addressed to this email or by text or voicemail to 07969 875464.

NB there will be a copy of the new Bye-Laws with the minutes of the Management Committee, in the Clubhouse bar area (under the tv).
